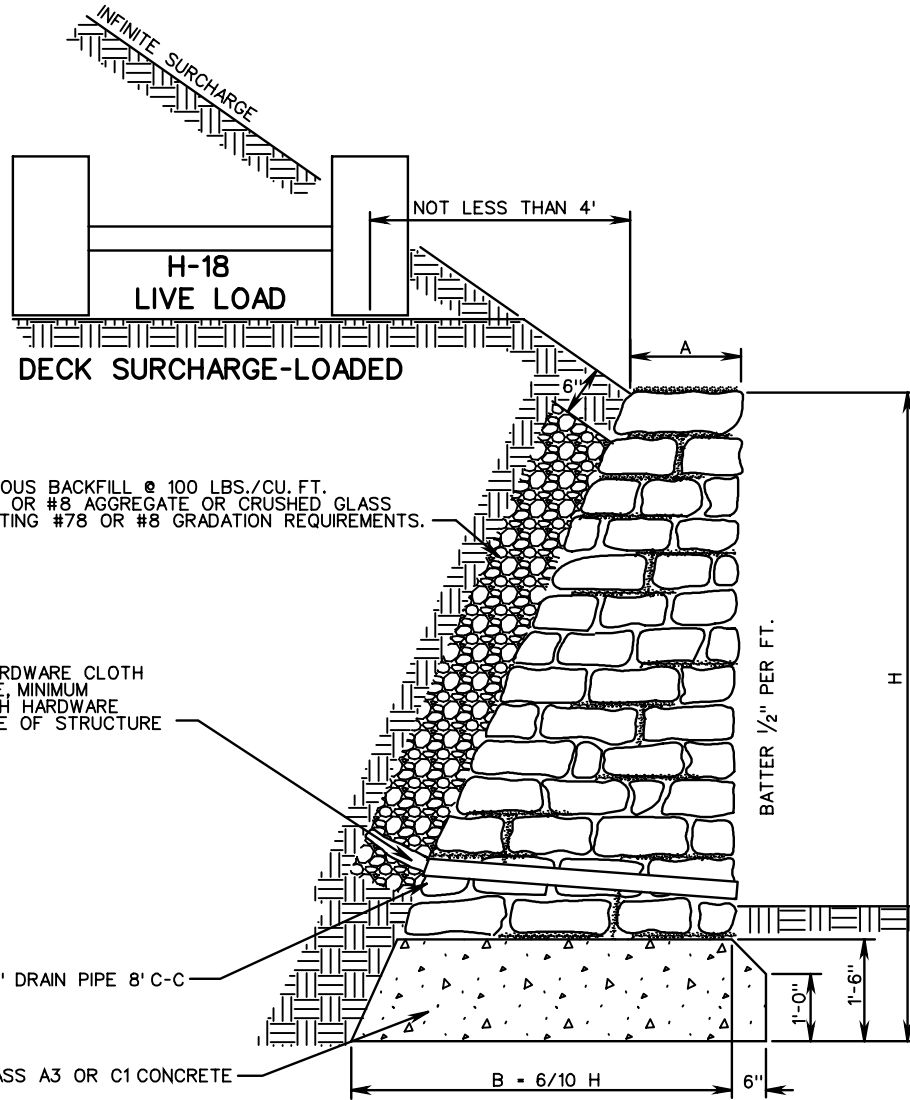

WEEP HOLE WITH 12"x12" PLASTIC HARDWARE CLOTH 1/4" MESH OR GALVANIZED STEEL WIRE, MINIMUM WIRE DIAMETER 0.03", NUMBER 4 MESH HARDWARE CLOTH ANCHORED FIRMLY TO OUTSIDE OF STRUCTURE

DRAIN PIPES ARE TO BE ONE CONTINUOUS LENGTH OR BELL AND SPIGOT WITH MORTARED JOINTS.

H = HEIGHT IN FEET

BASE = 6/10 H

WT. EARTH = 100 LBS./CU. FT.

WT. RUBBLE = 150 LBS./CU. FT.

ANGLE OF REPOSE = 1 1/2 : 1

NOTE:
