

NOTES:

1. THE DEPTH OF PROTECTION WILL DEPEND ON WHATEVER DEPTH IS ATtAINABLE, WITH THE RIPRAP BEING EVENLY SPREAD WITH THE QUANTITY SHOWN ON THESE PLANS. RIPRAP MAY BE ADDED OR DELETED AS FOUND NECESSARY BY THE ENGINEER.

FOR STABILIZED
CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE

PROFILE

1. SURFACE WATER SHALL BE PIPED UNDER THE CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE. IF PIPING IS IMPRACTICAL, A MOUNTABLE BERM WITH 5:1 SLOPES WILL BE PERMITTED.
2. THE ENTRANCE SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A CONDITION WHICH WILL PREVENT TRACKING OR FLOWING OF SEDIMENT ONTO PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY. THIS MAY REQUIRE PERIODIC TOP DRESSING WITH ADDITIONAL STONE AS CONDITIONS DEMAND AND REPAIR AND/OR CLEANOUT OF ANY MEASURES USED TO TR
SEDIMENT. ALL SEDIMENT SPILLED, DROPPED, WASHED OR TRACKED ONTO PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY SHALL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY.
3. WHEELS SHALL BE CLEANED TO REMOVE SEDIMENT PRIOR TO ENTRANCE ONTO PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY. WHEN WASHING IS REQUIRED, IT SHALL BE ONE ON AN AREA STABLIZED WITH STONE AND WHICH DRAINS INTO AN approved sediment trapping device.
4.PERIODIC INSPECTION AND NEEDED MAINTENANCE SHALL BE PROVIDED AFTER HEAVY USE AND EACH RAIN.
