PRE-DESIGN FUNDS

- Planning funds for each district are provided in the SYIP for use on certain pre-design activities.
- The amount of pre-scoping funds for each district is determined based on the size of the construction program.
- Each district is provided a pre-design UPC number and expenditures shall be charged directly to these UPCs; the funds may not be transferred.
- These state funds are planning program funds, not construction program funds, and may only be used for pre-design activities such as those listed on the following page.
- Each district is responsible for managing these funds, including monitoring expenditures and ensuring the expenditures do not exceed the allocations.
