ON STANDARD TC-5.04ULS, TC-5.01U , AND TC-5.01R (WITHOUT PAVEMENT WIDENING) SUPERELEVATED CURVES, POSITION THE SUPERELEVATION RUNOFF SECTION (Lr) TWO THIRDS (2/3) ON THE TANGENT AND ONE THIRD (1/3) INTO THE CURVE. STATIONS AND ELEVATIONS FOR THESE TRANSITIONS WILL NEED TO BE COMPUTED FOR TS, SC, CS, ST AND EVERY 25' INCREMENT (i.e., 10+00, 10+25, 10+50, 10+75, etc...)
