Roadway Typical Section

By combining Multimodal Center Type with Corridor Modal Emphasis and Roadway Typology, the appropriate dimensions (minimum, optimum or in between) of the elements of design that define the roadway typical section are determined. However, if the optimum valve(s) cannot be met for the modal emphasis primary element(s) a design waiver shall be submitted in accordance with IIM-LD-227.
